# Guest Investigator & Fellows Programs

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- **GI Program (ROSES 2007):**
  - **GLAST Appendix (D.9) specifies 2-stage review:**
    - **Stage 1: Scientific merit (“Regular” and “Large” proposals, each with specified cost caps)**
    - **Stage 2: Cost reasonableness evaluation for “science winners”**
- **Fellows Program (not part of ROSES):**
  - **First proposals due November 2007**
  - **Selections made February 2008**
  - **Fellows to start September 2008**
